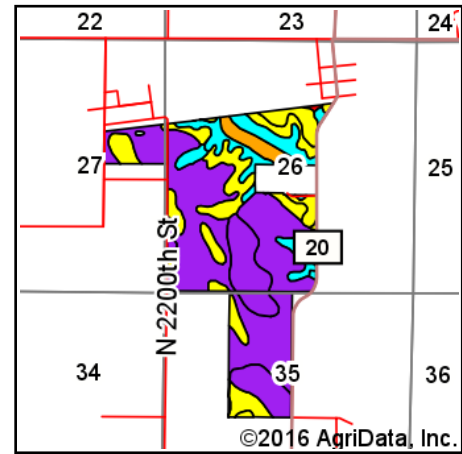
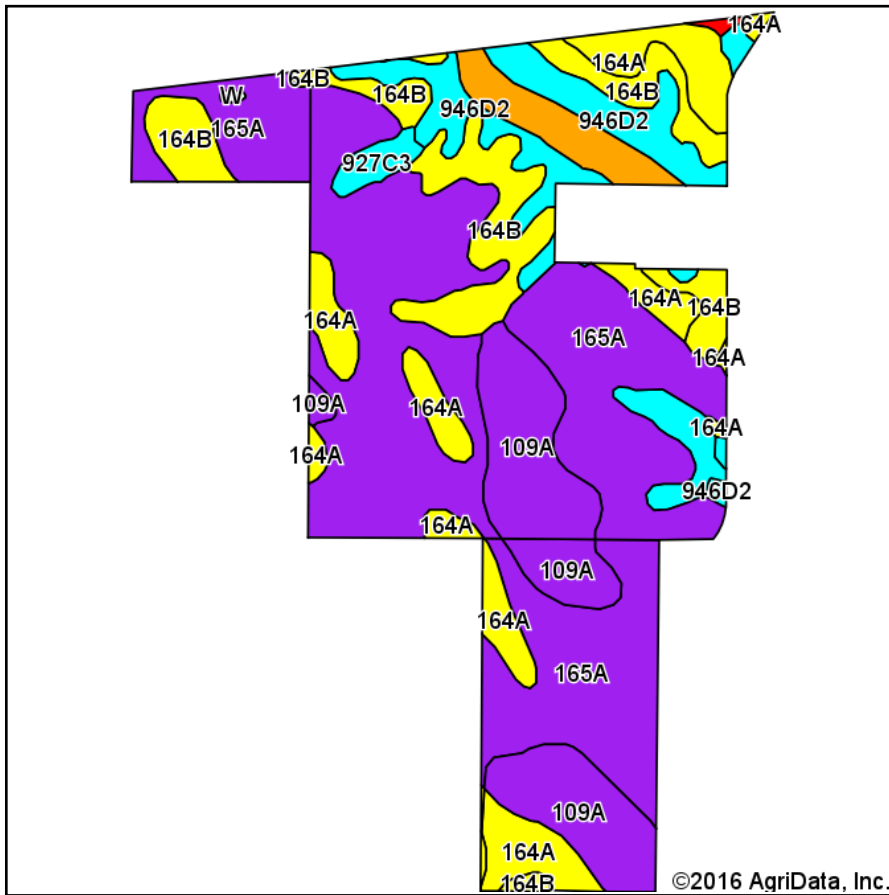


Doll FFF II LP Soils Map
